3. The oral class of 4 animals will be nominated by the Overjudge or Chief Steward before judging commences.

COMPETITION TIMING

From the point of view of the competitors, the animals and the spectators, it is important that the whole competition be completed in approximately one hour.

In the case of 3 classes of animals being used, the timing would be as follows:

- Judging 3 classes - 8 minutes each
- Competitors' oral tests - 3 minutes each
