General Information

The Dalgety Show Horse Section is run by a group of VOLUNTEERS forming the Horse Section Committee. Any attendees or competitors wishing to help this group are more than welcome to assist with the lead up to the show or on the day. Please contact the Show Secretary on if you would like to help.

Entries

- Ticket office will be open from **6:30am Sunday morning until 11am.**
- Show jumping entries and yards will be available on Global Entries from **Monday the 29th until Friday the 1st of March.** Show jumping can also be entered Sunday morning at the ticket office. **Any riders who enter on Global Entries will still need to sign a physical waiver.**
- Stockman's Challenge entries will be taken at the Stockman's Challenge immediately before the event.

Showground Entry

COVID REQUIREMENTS- will comply with State Health Orders at the time of the event.

Gate entry must be paid for all competitors & their family/friends/assistants. Showground entry tickets can be purchased at the entry gate to the showground. Everyone must wear their Dalgety Show wristband whilst in the showgrounds.

Horse Secretaries Office

The Office will be open on Sunday 6.30am- 11am for show ring and show jumping entries and signing of waivers.

Tickets, Wristbands, Waivers, Fees, and Prize Money

- Wristband will be issued on receipt of waiver. All riders/handlers and assistants must have a wristband to enter in all rings.
- Tickets are to be surrendered to Ring Stewards upon entry to the relevant ring. Wristbands must be worn. Entry to warm up rings or arena will not be permitted without a wristband.
- Anyone leading horses for younger riders are required to submit a waiver.
- Lost or misplaced entry tickets will not be refunded or re-produced.
- No refunds will be given for unused tickets or tickets purchased on the day. Refunds may be issued for pre-purchased entries, prior to commencement of the show, upon providing a veterinary or medical certificate at the discretion of the Dalgety Show Society.
- All entry fees and prizes are specified on the schedule under their appropriate ring heading or class.

- Prize money for rings 1-2 will be presented at the same time as placings.
- Hack and Hunter classes. Competitors may not compete in both classifications.
- Breed/OTT registration certificates will be required and produced on request.

Rider Apparel

- Ring 1-2 – no roper boots.
- Show jumping – shirts of solid colour only, no jeans/stockman pants or roper boots.
- Stockman's Challenge competitors under 18 years of age must wear a helmet

Parking

Parking within the showground is extremely limited. Parking is issued on a first in, first served basis with no bookings taken.

Vehicle Entry and Exits

Horse floats and trucks may enter the grounds through Gate 2 only until 7am on show day. After this time, Gate 2 will be closed to all traffic until 3pm as this is a frequent pedestrian passage. Any floats and trucks leaving prior to 3pm will be required to exit via Gate 3, which is a grass exit with a slight incline. This exit is unsuitable for large floats and trucks due to the tight corner involved. Any large trucks and floats wishing to camp on Saturday night yet wishing to leave the showground prior to 3pm will be required to remove their vehicle from the grounds via Gate 2 prior to 7am on show day.

Yards & Hot Tape

Dalgety Showground has 55 yards available for use. Showground yards must be pre-booked and attract a fee of \$5 per yard (valid for use on Saturday 6th and Sunday 7th March only). Yard positions will be assigned on a random basis unless a specific location has been requested. **YARDS MUST NOT BE EXTENDED.** Bookings for yards will only be accepted through Global Entries Online. Select a Round per yard required. If maximum number of rounds is reached, select additional yards from separate yard 'class'.

Due to restricted space, portable yards are a max 3x3m per horse but can be combined into 1 larger yard to accommodate multiple horses (i.e. 1x 9x9 yard to house 3 horses together).

If a horse is in a yard assigned to someone else, the horse may be relocated to a safe area by Show Officials. This may also occur if there is a welfare concern for the horse. The horse will be placed in a safe area and the owner must present to the Horse Steward Gazebo. No compensation will be made if a class is missed due to their horse having been relocated.

Camping

Free-of-charge camping is available but is limited inside the grounds. Should power be required, competitors are advised to bring a long, tagged extension lead. Leads will be checked and if not Tested & Tagged, they may be removed. **PLEASE NOTE:** There are limited showers at the Showgrounds.

If anyone camping on site anticipates leaving the grounds prior to 3pm on show day, they are advised to remove their vehicle from the grounds prior to 7am on the same day (see above section on Vehicle Entry & Exits). It is highly recommended that large trucks, goosenecks etc planning on leaving prior to 3pm do move their vehicles due to the restricted access and tight corner involved in exiting the grounds via Gate 3.

Dogs

Dogs must be on a lead AT ALL TIMES. Dogs must not be taken in the vicinity of the show rings, warm up or show jumping rings.

Rules & Regulations

CRUELTY TO ANIMALS IN ANY FORM WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

- All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows, which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au. Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.
- The Show Society will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each competitor/responsible guardian must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Dalgety Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. On each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.
- All riders must wear EA approved headwear, as listed below, at any time whilst on horseback:
 - (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI Global marked.
 - New Australian standard ARB HS 2012 provided they are SAI Global marked.
 - Current American standard ASTM F1163 (2004a or 04a onwards) provided they are SEI marked.
 - Current American standard SNELL E2001.
 - Current British standard PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI Kitemarked.
 - Interim European Standard VG1 (01.040: 2014-12) with or without BSI Kitemark.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to change the program at any time.
- Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to classes at any time. This will be done if there are concerns for the welfare of the horse or safety of the rider, other competitors, officials, or spectators.
- Competitors must choose between Hack and Hunter and may not compete in both.
- Rings will not be delayed or held up for competitors. Competitors may be required to choose between classes in the event they clash.
- No person is permitted to enter the ring or approach the judge unless announced by the steward to enter for a class. No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has, or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.
- All protests must be submitted in writing with a \$50.00 fee within 30 minutes of completion of the class to the Horse Steward Gazebo.
- Dalgety Show does not have an official stand and all decisions will be made at the discretion of the Ring Judge.

Stallions:

- May not compete in open classes hack or hunter (exc ANSA).
- Must be controlled with a bit at all times.
- May compete in show jumping events.
- Must be controlled by a person 17 years or older except ASH, which is 18 years.
- The judge may use his/her discretion to determine if a suitable number of entrants are present for each class. If there are an unsuitable number of entrants, the judge may choose to abandon the class or combine the class with a similar class and judge to a suitable mediation.

- Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground.
- Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.
- The age of all horses is calculated as from 1st August. Every horse foaled before 1st August in year shall be deemed to be 1 year old on that date.
- Novice – not placed first in an individual class hack, hunter, or riding class at any equivalent show.
- Drug testing may be carried out at this show.
- Dogs must not be taken into the vicinity of the warm-up area, jumping or show rings and must be restrained at all times when in camping/parking areas.
- All horses in Breed Classes must be registered in the relevant Association/Society and must have papers present at the show. These papers must be presented upon request of the stewards.
- Competitors affected by alcohol or illicit drugs will be immediately removed from competition without refund of entry fees.
- All power/electrical leads being used MUST be Tested & Tagged.

Local Hack/Hunter

- Both horse and rider must reside within the following postcodes:
 - 2627
 - 2628
 - 2629
- This information must be provided on waivers and will be checked.
- Local hack/hunter wins are **not eligible** for royal qualifications.

Pony Club Riders

- Riders may not enter both the main rider class and the Pony Club rider class.
- The Pony Club rider class wins are **not eligible** for royal qualifications.
- This class is designed to encourage riders who do not have much experience in show riding to participate in a rider class.
- Riders should wear their Pony Club uniform or similar attire (no riding jackets).
- Riders **do not** have to be a member of Pony Club to ride in the Pony Club rider class.
- The judge may decide to merge the Pony Club and main rider class, or relevant Pony Club classes if numbers are insufficient.

Equestrian Australia Affiliation

Affiliation with Equestrian Australia (EA) is voluntary. Each Show Society has the choice as to whether they become affiliated with EA. If Show Societies are affiliated with EA, all Exhibitors will need to comply with the EA Base Registration for Show jumping which will be introduced on 1 January 2024. Those Show Societies not affiliated with EA are not compelled to comply with EA Base Registration Rules. Dalgety Show 2024 is not affiliated with EA.

Approximate start time 3pm, around completion of the ASH classes.

Riders may practice the obstacles in a sensible and safe manner prior to start of the competition.

Riders may enter multiple horses.

All riders must sign a waiver prior to competing, these will be available at the event.

Riders under 18 years of age must wear a helmet.

Rules:

Each obstacle is worth an allocated number of points and each run is timed. Riders are allowed 2 attempts at each obstacle, with the maximum points attainable on the 2nd attempt being 5 points. After the 2nd unsuccessful attempt riders will be instructed to move to the next obstacle. **The horse and rider combination with the highest points and fastest time wins.**

Obstacles to expect: Participants will have the opportunity to practise the obstacles prior to start of event.

- Jump
 - Wool bale
 - Laying down single barrel
 - Hay bales
- Chaff bag drag
- Curtain
- Seesaw
- Backing
- Side pass
- Tyre
- Lasso (points for throw only awarded if horse is immobile)
- Tarp
- Spinning horse carousel

THE NIMMITY BELL SHOWJUMPING POINTSCORE

Established in 1981 (Updated 2023)

Prizes: Rug + 1st \$450; 2nd \$240; 3rd \$160; 4th \$115; 5th \$60

The "Nimmity Bell" show jumping pointscore is a competition run over 4 shows – Nimmitabel, Delegate, Dalgety, and Bombala. The "Nimmity Bell" trophy is to be awarded to the horse & rider combination with the highest pointscore in open competition over 4 shows. This will be awarded at the completion of events at the Bombala Showjumping events.

1. Horses can only score in **80cm** or higher, novelty events excluded, all entrants in these events will be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" regardless of the total amount of entries in one class.
2. A horse & rider combination can only score once at each show. This score will be their best placing from that show. If a horse fails to place in an event, it will score zero for that show. The points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 point, **no placing yet eligible = 0 points. In the case of "tied" placings the points will be spilt, the same way as prizemoney.**
3. **Horses and rider combination must compete at all 4 shows** to be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore". The only exception will be if an official vet / doctor's certificate is presented to the official scorer indicating the horse/ rider's inability to compete at one of the 4 shows.
4. Any disputes regarding the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" must be directed to Anita Walder 0428613344 to be dealt with. Official protest/s must be made in writing within 1 hour of the class being completed and must be accompanied by \$50.00 and presented to the chief steward of the relevant show.
5. **Please note: It is requested that EA summer dress standards apply for competitors at all four shows** (no polo shirts – shirt with tie or stock to be worn).
6. **Overall prize money will be awarded to the top 5 place getters at the completion of events at Bombala Show.**
