Ring 2 – Pre-entry only, no entries on the day
Ring 3 Fun Ring – Pre-entry or enter on the day
Ring 4 Sporting – Pre-entry or enter on the day
Ring 5 Showjumping – Pre-entry only, no entries on the day

NOTE: ALL ENTRIES ON GLOBAL ARE UNDER THE CATEGORY OF EQUESTRIAN: SHOWJUMPING, INCLUDING RINGS 1-4

- Pre-entries are made through Global Entries Online. On show day, competitors
 or their representative are asked to provide the Global Entries confirmation
 email to the 'Global Entries' line at the Horse Section Gazebo where they will be
 provided with an envelope containing their tickets (n/a for jumping events) and
 waiver band. Competitors are asked to complete their waiver online through
 Global Entries when completing their entries. If this has not been competed,
 they will be required to complete a waiver and hand it to the steward prior to
 being given their ticket envelope.
- Competitors entering on the day (Rings 3 & 4 only) will be required to submit a
 completed waiver along with the appropriate fee to the Horse Section gazebo
 'Rings 3 & 4 Tickets ONLY' line. Anyone leading horses for younger riders are
 also required to submit a waiver. Riders and handlers will be issued with a wrist
 band, which they are to wear at any time they are competing, and their entry
 tickets which are to be surrendered to Ring Stewards upon entry to that ring.
- All competitors will be issued with a wristband upon handing in their signed
 waivers/collecting pre-entered tickets and this must be worn whilst competing or
 entry may be prohibited. Wristbands are not transferrable as they indicate a
 waiver has been completed for a particular competitor.
- Riders and competitors in Ring 3 are not eligible to enter Rings 1 or 2.
- Lost or misplaced entry tickets will not be refunded or re-produced.
- The Horse Steward Gazebo will be open from 7am on Sunday 5th March 2016.

- No refunds will be given for tickets purchased on the day. Refunds may be issued for pre-purchased tickets for all rings upon providing a veterinary or medical certificate at the discretion of the Dalgety Show Society.
- Entry fees and Prizes all entry fees and prizes are specified on the schedule under their appropriate ring heading or class.
- Prize money can only be collected after 11am from the Horse Steward gazebo and must be collected on the day or it will be forfeited.

Notes for 2017

This year the Dalgety Show does not have a Chief Horse Steward and is run by the Horse Section Committee. The program has been created by a group of volunteers and based on attendance records of past shows and therefore classes may have been extended or combined. Any attendees willing to help out in the lead up to or on the day of the show would be greatly appreciated and they can express their interest by emailing the Dalgety Show Society Secretary on secretary@dalgetyshow.com.au

Yards

Dalgety Showground has 64 yards available for use. Showground yards must be pre-booked and attract a fee of \$5 per yard (valid for use on Saturday 4th and Sunday 5th March only). Yard positions will be assigned on a random basis unless a specific location has been requested. Bookings for yards will only be accepted through Global Entries Online and are open from 12am 1st February.

Hot tape/electrical tape is now permitted for camping and day yards in accordance with the RAS guidelines approved in August 2015. A WAIVER MUST BE CO-SIGNED BY ONE OF THE MEMBERS FROM THE DALGETY SHOW SOCIETY AND THIS CAN BE ARRANGED AT THE HORSE GAZEBO.

If a horse is in a yard assigned to someone else, the horse may be relocated to a safe area by Show Officials. This may also occur if there is a welfare concern for the horse. The horse will be placed in a safe area and the owner must present to the Horse Steward Gazebo. No compensation will be made if a class is missed due to their horse having been relocated.

Parking

Due to Ring 3 and the Warm Up ring being held in the hockey field area of the showground, parking within the showground is extremely limited. Parking is issued on a first in, first served basis with no bookings taken.

Vehicle Entry and Exits

Horse floats and trucks may enter the grounds through Gate 2 only until 7am on show day. After this time, Gate 2 will be closed to all traffic until 3pm as this is a frequent pedestrian passage. Any floats and trucks leaving prior to 3pm will be required to exit via Gate 3 which is a grass exit with a slight incline. This exit is unsuitable for large floats and trucks due to the tight corner involved. Any large trucks and floats wishing to camp on Saturday night yet wishing to leave the showground prior to 3pm will be required to remove their vehicle from the grounds via Gate 2 prior to 7am on show day.

Classic cars will be located in a different location this year and will therefore not be required to drive through the horse parking area.

Camping


Free-of-charge camping is available but is limited inside the grounds. Should power be required, competitors are advised to bring a long, tagged extension lead. Leads will be checked and if not Tested & Tagged, they may be removed. Two showers are available in the Pavilion free of charge. If anyone camping on site anticipates leaving the grounds prior to 3pm on show day, they are advised to remove their vehicle from the grounds prior to 7am on the same day (see above section on Vehicle Entry & Exits).

Rules & Regulations

CRUELTY TO ANIMALS IN ANY FORM WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED

- This event is an EA affiliated event and as such Ring events are run in accordance with the Equestrian Australia National Show Horse Rules. Exceptions to attire are permitted for Ring 3 and 4 which is considered 'Fun & Sporting Classes'. All Show jumping classes are run in accordance with the Equestrian Australia National Jumping Rules. All results will be forwarded to both EA and ASC.
- All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the
 Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at
 Shows which can be viewed at www.agshowsnsw.org.au. Should it become
 necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any
 aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty
 imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties
 resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW shows.
- The Show Society will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Dalgety Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.
- All competitors & the family/friends/assistants must pay show entry and wear their wristband whilst in the show grounds.
- All riders must wear EA approved headwear, as listed below, at any time whilst on horseback, including walking jump courses, warming up and walking to or from rings.
 - Current Australian standard AS/NZ 3838 (2006 onwards) provided they are SAI global marked.
 - New Australian standard ARB HS 2012 provided they are SAI global marked

- Current American standards ASTM FII63 (2004a or 04a onwards) provided they are SEI marked, or SNELL E2001.
- Current British standard PAS 015 (1998 or 2011) provided they are BSI Kitemarked
- Interim European Standard VGI (01.040: 2014-12) with or without BSI Kitemark.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to change the program at any time.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to refuse entry to classes at any time.
 This will be done of there are concerns for the welfare of the horse or safety of the rider, other competitors, officials or spectators.
- Competitors must choose between Hack and Hunter and may not compete in both.
- Rings will not be delayed or held up for competitors. Competitors may be required to choose between classes in the event they clash.
- No person is allowed to enter the ring or approach the judge unless announced by the steward to enter for a class. No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.
- All protests must be submitted in writing with a \$50.00 fee within 30 minutes of completion of the class to the Horse Steward Gazebo.
- Dalgety Show does not have an official measuring stand and all decisions will be made at the discretion of the Ring Judge.
- Stallions May not compete in open classes hack or hunter (exc ANSA). Must be controlled with a bit at all times. May compete in show jumping events. Must have a bit and be controlled by a person 17 years or older except ASH which is 18 years.
- The judge may use his/her discretion to determine if a suitable number of
 entrants are present for each class. If there are an unsuitable number of
 entrants, the judge may chose to abandon the class or combine the class with a
 similar class and judge to a suitable mediation.
- Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground.
- Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.
- The age of all horses is calculated as from 1st August. Every horse foaled before 1st August in year shall be deemed to be 1 year old on that date
- Novice not placed first in an individual class hack, hunter or riding class at any
 equivalent show.
- Drug testing may be carried out at this show.
- Dogs must not be taken into the vicinity of the warm up area, jumping or show rings and must be restrained at all times when in camping/parking areas.
- All horses in Breed Classes must be registered in the relevant Association/Society and must have papers present at the show. These papers must be presented upon request of the stewards.
- Competitors affected by alcohol or illicit drugs will be immediately removed from competition without refund of entry fees.
- All power/electrical leads being used MUST be Tested & Tagged.

Dress Code: Neat, tidy & practical suitable attire. Approved helmets & boots MUST be worn for all classes & whilst mounted.

Assisted Classes: Rider/handler is to control horse as much as possible. Assister is to assist only where the child is having difficulty. Any horses on lead must be lead by the shoulder.

Horse Eligibility: Horses participating in other rings may be used. These classes will be judged based on the rider/handler and not necessarily the horse. Judging will not be compromised if horses are not braided, clipped, groomed to show horse standard etc.

THE NIMMITY BELL SHOWJUMPING POINTSCORE Established in 1981

PLEASE NOTE Revised rules made by show committees

The "Nimmity Bell" showjumping pointscore is a competition run over 4 shows – Nimmitabel, Delegate, Dalgety and Bombala. The "Nimmity Bell" trophy is to be awarded to the horse with the highest pointscore in open competition over 4 shows. This will be awarded at the completion of EA events at the Bombala Show.

- 1. Only horses registered with the EA of NSW are eligible for the pointscore. Horses can only score in EA events that potentially count for grading, i.e. the event is 1.05m or higher, the event has a total prize pool worth \$100 or more, the event is officiated by an EA accredited Judge and Course Designer. All entrants in these events will be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" regardless of the total amount of entries in one class.
- 2. A horse can only score once at each show. This score will be the horse's best top 3 placings from that show. If a horse fails to place in an event, it will score zero for that show. The points will be awarded as follows: 1st = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th = 1 point, no placing yet eligible = 0 points. In the case of "tied" placings the points will be spilt.
- **3**. **Horses must compete at all 4 shows** to be eligible for the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore". The only exception will be if an official vet certificate is presented to the official scorer indicating the horse's inability to compete at one of the 4 shows.
- 4. Results will be forwarded for recording results, from the official Judge / show committee of each show and then allocating points according to the rules above. Any disputes regarding the "Nimmity Bell Pointscore" must be directed to the Official point scorer to be dealt with. Official protest/s must be made in writing within 1 hour of the class being completed and must be accompanied by \$50.00 and presented to the Official Point scorer. All events are EA events and will be run in accordance to EA rules.
- **5**. EA summer dress standards apply for competitors (no polo shirts shirt with tie or stock to be worn).
- **6**. Overall prize money will be awarded to the top 5 place getters at the completion of EA events at Bombala Show.
